107/07 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING - The minutes of the previous meeting were agreed. These were signed off by the Chairman for the records.

108/07 MATTERS ARISING – Nothing mentioned from any persons present

Vice chair Jennie was intent on submitting the necessary application for the planning permission (this has now been done and confirmed) Parish Council confirmed that there was £800 ringfenced for the sculpture.
