117/07 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING - The minutes of the previous meeting were unavailable and will be signed off at the next meeting by the Chairman, for the records.

121/07 PLANNING – Outline application for building of 4 houses in Meadow View has been rejected.

The idea of getting someone from the Police to speak was discussed. Mike Williams said that Malcolm Blanksby had informed him that we would need to write to the Police, but as a Police Officer is already speaking at a Parish Council meeting in the near future, he was not sure if they would be willing to speak at the AGM as well.



Robin St. John Smith suggested holding the AGM at the Rebellion Brewery. He will liaise with Tim/Mark and we could fit in with their availability. If we are unable to hold it at the Brewery, it was suggested that we ask Carol Whittington, Head of Burford School, if she would be willing to speak. Mike Williams agreed to contact her.

123/07 SIR STEVE REDGRAVE PROJECT – The Parish Council has objected to the application on the grounds that "it would be intrusive to the street scene and to the adjacent residents of Patches Field owing to its size and location". Jennie Browning discussed this with Parish Council, who said that if the Sculpture was sited on the grass on the right at the very entrance to Marlow Bottom, they would not object. However, no official reply has been received from WDC as yet.

124/07 SUCCESSION PLANNING – Robin St. John Smith confirmed that he has accepted the position of Treasurer, following the AGM.
