Well done RN for winning the 'go for gold' class competition

As you may know, each time a (KS1) child gets a sticker at the end of a row on their 'go for gold' card, they also add a sticker to their class chart.

As of July 14th, the class with the most stickers on their class chart was **RN**. Their total recorded walks for the year was 3,310 (331 stickers), that's 110 for each child, or nearly 3 walks a week for each every child in that class. Well done RN and keep up the good walking!

Although Years 1 and 2 didn't get as many stickers, we recognize that this isn't necessarily a reflection of the number of times they walk, but shows the power of rewards for the younger children.

What we hope is that 'go for gold' helps establish good walking habits from the earliest age, and that these children will continue to walk regularly - for the benefit of their health and the local environment.

All the results were:

Class	Total walks/stickers
RN	3,310/331
RS	3,180/318
1CG	2,630/263
1CJ	2,530/253
2C	1,910/191
2H	1,860/186



Finally - if you think 'go for gold' is helpful - would you consider sparing 15 minutes once a fortnight to be a stamper. From September, the 'go for gold' team will need more stampers - more details after the holidays.

Remember to keep your 'go for gold' card for September - you will continue from where you left off this summer.



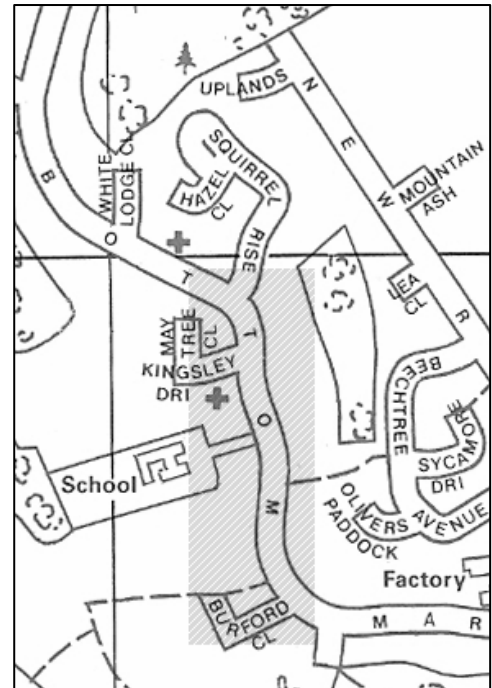
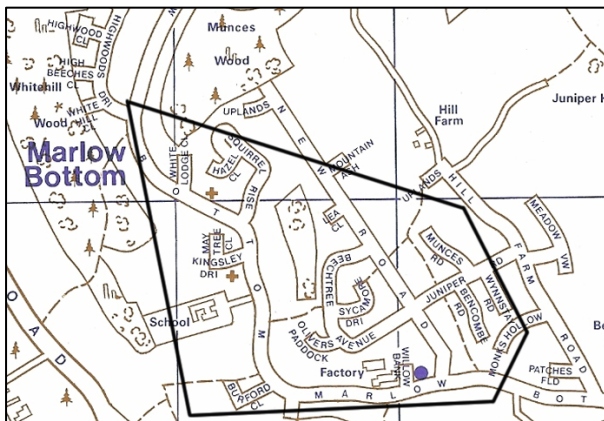

New maps drawn up to identify driving 'hotspots'

Some new maps have been drawn up, and given to all the parents of the children who will be joining Burford in September.

Although this information should be familiar to those families already at Burford, a little reminder may be beneficial.

This first map below identifies the 'exclusions zone'. This is the area you must walk from (unless you live closer to school) to get a 'go for gold' stamp.



This second map above identifies the area of **main concern of parking problems**. We regularly receive complaints - please ensure it's not about you by parking and turning considerably around school.

In September we will re-issue the Driver's Code of Conduct to help remind everybody about the important points.
